Tour the first-of-its-kind NYC Greenroof Environmental Literacy Laboratory at PS 41, a unique outdoor space that provides students with a fresh observational learning experience

The GELL Project- a Green Roof Environmental Literacy Laboratory is a 15,000 square foot vista of greenery and "living" rooftop classroom located at PS 41- The Greenwich Village School in Manhattan.

Over six years in the making, it opened in September 2012, and is the first official green roof project by N.Y.C School Construction Authority, with the support and funding by elected officials. It is the largest green roof on a public school in New York City. The tour will be led by key members of the GELL project team: Project Architect Jose Miranda (Murphy, Burnham & Buttrick), Project Manager Agata Swikiak-Vetter (formally of Jonathan Rose Companies and now with Zubatkin), and Michael Yoken M.A.L.D. Regenerative Landscape Planning & Design
